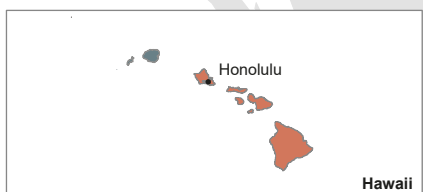
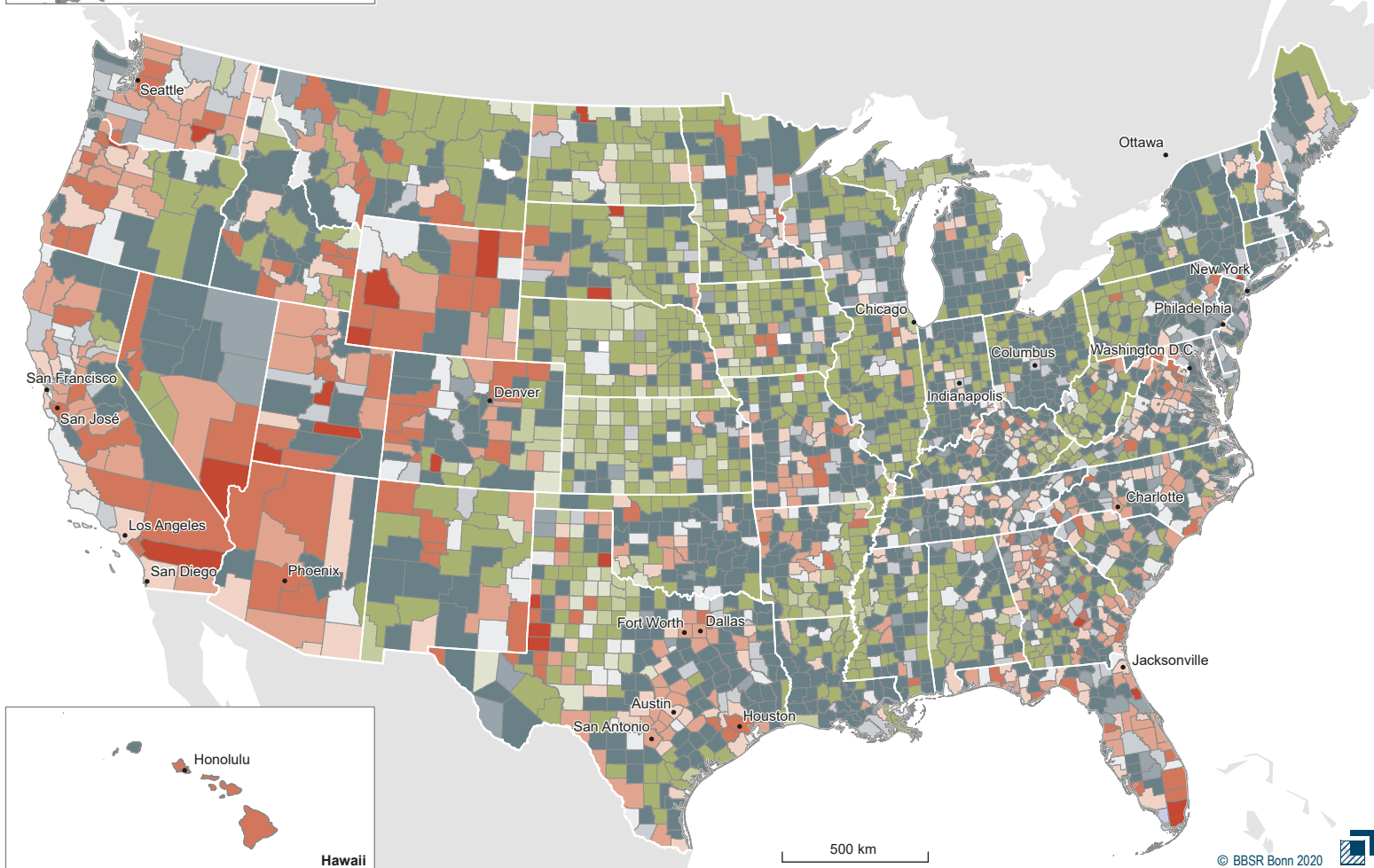
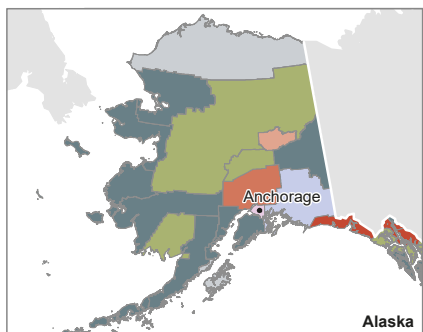


# Development of built-up area in relation to population development in the United States of America

Ratio of the annual percentage change of built-up area and population change between 1990 and 2014

- with an increase of built-up area by declining population
  - up to below -1.0
  - 1.0 up to below -0.5
  - 0.5 up to below 0.0
- with an increase of population higher than the increase of built-up area
  - 0.0 up to below 0.25
  - 0.25 up to below 0.5
  - 0.5 up to below 0.75
  - 0.75 up to below 1.0
- with an increase of built-up area higher than the increase of population
  - 1.0 up to below 1.25
  - 1.25 up to below 1.5
  - 1.5 up to below 1.75
  - 1.75 and more
